Jungle Express:
- Departs from the station adjacent to Jungle Kingdom at approx. half an hour intervals.
 Travel through the woods, into a tunnel and onto Half Mile Lake where you may be lucky enough to see the Sea Lions,
Pelicans and Nico the Gorilla.
Deer Valley:
- Opportunity to hand feed a fallow deer (£1.00).
Adventure Castle:
- Spend hours exploring this enchanting Medieval fortress and exciting adventure playground with swings, bridges,
tunnels and nets.
- Subject to the weather a Splashpad will also be in operation. Be careful where you tread - there's a water jet waiting
to leap up and spray you when you're least expecting it! May be worth bringing a towel!
Hedge Maze:
- There's nearly 1 ³ / ₄ miles of paths hedged by more than 16,000 English Yews with twists and turns galore. The
mysterious Hedge Maze keeps everyone guessing! As you figure out your way through, you'll come across 6 bridges
where you'll get tantalising glimpses of the observation tower that is your target. But how close are you? And when
will you get there? However long it takes, you'll have loads of fun along the way!
